News From The Bishop Search Committee

We need to hear from **you**, our diocese. The Bishop Search Committee is planning a series of listening sessions in early September and everyone is invited to attend and participate. Our format will give everyone an opportunity to be heard. These sessions will be held throughout the diocese, with separate sessions for lay members, priests, and deacons. We plan to hold these sessions during the first part of September. If you are unable to attend in person, this won't be the only opportunity to have your voice heard. We will also be conducting surveys, available both online and in print. We will also have Spanish language listening sessions and a Spanish speaker will be available at all sessions. Episcopal Climate News green-living tip of the week: **Let's eat less meat!**



The food system is responsible for 25% of all global greenhouse-gas emissions, and up to 80% of that is associated with livestock. This means that our diets are as key to solving climate change as are transportation and electricity!

While a vegetarian diet is the best way to "go green," it isn't the only way to lower our carbon footprints. Try eliminating meat at just two to three more meals per week, or at special parish events. Switching from beef to chicken can also make a big difference: One pound of beef requires the same amount of CO₂ as driving 138 miles. A pound of chicken equals a much lower 35 miles! Beans and other vegetarian staples, on the other hand, are responsible for almost no CO₂ emissions at all. The good news is that summer is a fantastic time to check out all the vegetable and fruits in season at your local farmer's market: Berries, melons, tomatoes, radishes, arugula, beets, peppers, garlic, and so much more.
