

The Rev. Martin Yabroff: Guest Preacher on Father's Day, Sunday, June 19

St. Philip's is pleased to have our founding Vicar, The Rev. Martin Yabroff, visiting on Father's Day! Fr. Martin might be considered the "father" of St. Philip's Church, as he and his wife, Eve, were the ones sent by Bishop Shannon Mallory to start a small Episcopal mission in Scotts Valley. On All Saints' Day, November 1, 1987, the first gathering of worshippers met at "Doctors on Duty" at Graham Plaza. Later they met in City Hall, and by 1995 this family style gathering had grown large enough (over 100 Sunday average attendance) that the diocese agreed to buy the Star Lodge, which is our current building. Martin and Eve had their final day at St. Philip's in October 2004, when he accepted a call to be Dean of a Cathedral in IN; his current position is as Rector, St. Andrew's, Tacoma, WA. Fr. Martin's visit on June 19 is part of his summer sabbatical, as he will be going from here to New Camaldoli Hermitage and Retreat Center in Big Sur. Pastor Mary will also be serving on Father's Day, and is offering special prayers for all fathers!
